

Four Free Continuing Education Modules For Every Class Of 2020 & 2021 Graduate Entering Workforce - FAQ

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. What are the eligible free courses?

You may refer to the list of courses [here](#) within the indicated eligibility period. Kindly note that seats will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Acceptance of your application is subjected to faculty availability, available capacity and is granted at the sole discretion of SITLEARN Professional Development.

2. When will the four (4) free CET courses be available?

The four (4) free CET courses will be available to 2020 & 2021 SIT graduate for courses starting from 1st Jun 2020 to 31st Mar 2022.

3. Who is eligible for the four (4) free CET courses?

You are eligible as long as you are conferred* in 2020/2021 with a Bachelor degree from any of the undergraduate programmes offered by:

- Singapore Institute of Technology,
- Joint degree by Singapore Institute of Technology and Overseas University partner,
- One of the Overseas University partners.

*Conferred: When a student has successfully completed his/her studies by meeting all the requirements of the programme, he/she will be put up to Chairman, Board of Trustees to be conferred his/her degree.

4. I am a graduating student this year, how do I go about receiving the SITizens Learning Credits and start applying for the four (4) free CET courses?

If you are a graduating student this year but have yet to be conferred, you can still apply for SLC – Eligible courses from 1st Jun 2020 to 31 Mar 2022.

Once you have been conferred*, you will receive an email from SIT Alumni and Advancement Team to activate your SITizens Learning Credits (SLC). You will still need to activate your SLC.

5. How is this new initiative different from the current SITizens Learning Credits scheme?

The new offering of four (4) free courses is leveraging on the SITizens Learning Credits scheme whereby the administrative fee of S\$42.80 (inclusive of GST) will be waived off for the first four (4) CET courses selected by the SIT's class of 2020/2021 graduate.

6. What will be my out-of-pocket expenses if I am a 2020/2021 SIT graduate who is a Singaporean or Singaporean PR?
